



## International Ranger Competition



As a group, you work together on the following International Challenge

### Notes:

- ✎ No more than 3 Rangers per entry
  - ✎ Each Ranger Company can have more than one entry
  - ✎ The actual competition will take place at the National Thinking Day Event on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2010 so you must be attending the event to take part.
- 
- Each section carries the same number of points
  - As a group, you choose one country from the list of four below and use the same country for sections A, B, and C. Prepare for all the sections before attending Thinking Day.
  - For part D you will need to have general knowledge of all four countries. This would include Guiding, geographical, culture etc.
  - Points will be given for full team participation and attendance. Remember to try to work hard as a team and have fun as we will give lots of points for that!

A) At the competition, cook a traditional one course meal from your chosen country on the list below. It must be cooked on a lightweight stove. Stove, ingredients and utensils etc must be brought by each individual group on the day.

N.B. Produce your menu for us to see and also a costing of the ingredients used.

B) Find a craft from your chosen country. Bring a finished article to the competition and be able to demonstrate this craft to the other participants.

C) Prepare a display on your chosen country and make a five minute presentation about it at the competition. This display should include history, culture and Guiding traditions of that country and, of course, anything else that you feel is relevant.

D) Take part in a table quiz at Thinking Day, which will be based on International Guiding knowledge and on the four countries below.

**The four countries to choose from are:**

*United Kingdom*

*Mexico*

*India*

*Switzerland*

**Remember** you must use the same country for parts A, B and C
