

Royal Society Protection of Birds

Require volunteers for the following and more:

- **Fundraising co-ordinator** - managing and supporting a team of local volunteers looking after pin badge boxes.
- **Sponsored Event Participant** - participate in any event as a team or on your own and raise money for a good cause.
- **Events Assistant** – assist with running promotional stands at events.
- **Community volunteer** – learn new skills and educate your community on birds and why we need to protect them. (Training given).
- **Community Fundraiser** - help develop recycling appeals in schools and businesses.
- **Social Event organiser** - help organise and run a fundraising event.

- **Person Centred Planning Facilitator** - Have you an interest in advocacy and human rights. Help facilitate a disabled persons 'circle of support' to enable them to fulfil their needs and ambitions. This role would suit someone with the ability to focus and lead a meeting working with statutory bodies. (Must have own transport)

Disability Sports N.I.

- Have you some spare time? Want to get involved in something fun? Why not become a 'BUDDY' and accompany a disabled person and assist them while they participate in sport in the Lakeland forum. Just One hour a week on Mon 11am-12pm.

Northern Ireland Children's Hospice, Horizon West Project

- **Fundraisers**- help carry out fundraising activities to raise much needed funds for

invaluable care provided by the project for children and families in your local area.

National Trust (Florence Court)

- **Book shop manager and assistants** - help set up and maintain a book shop at the beautiful Florence Court estate. Working within a team of volunteers to manage the day-to-day running of the shop.

RNID (Royal National Institute for the Deaf & hard of hearing)

- **Hearing Aid Volunteer** - Do you wear a hearing aid? Could you help other hearing aid users adapt to using a hearing aid and to overcome initial problems they may encounter. You would undertake a short period of support for clients in their own home. Training given.
- **Don't lose the music volunteer** - help raise awareness amongst other music fans about how to protect your hearing so that people can enjoy the music they love for longer.
